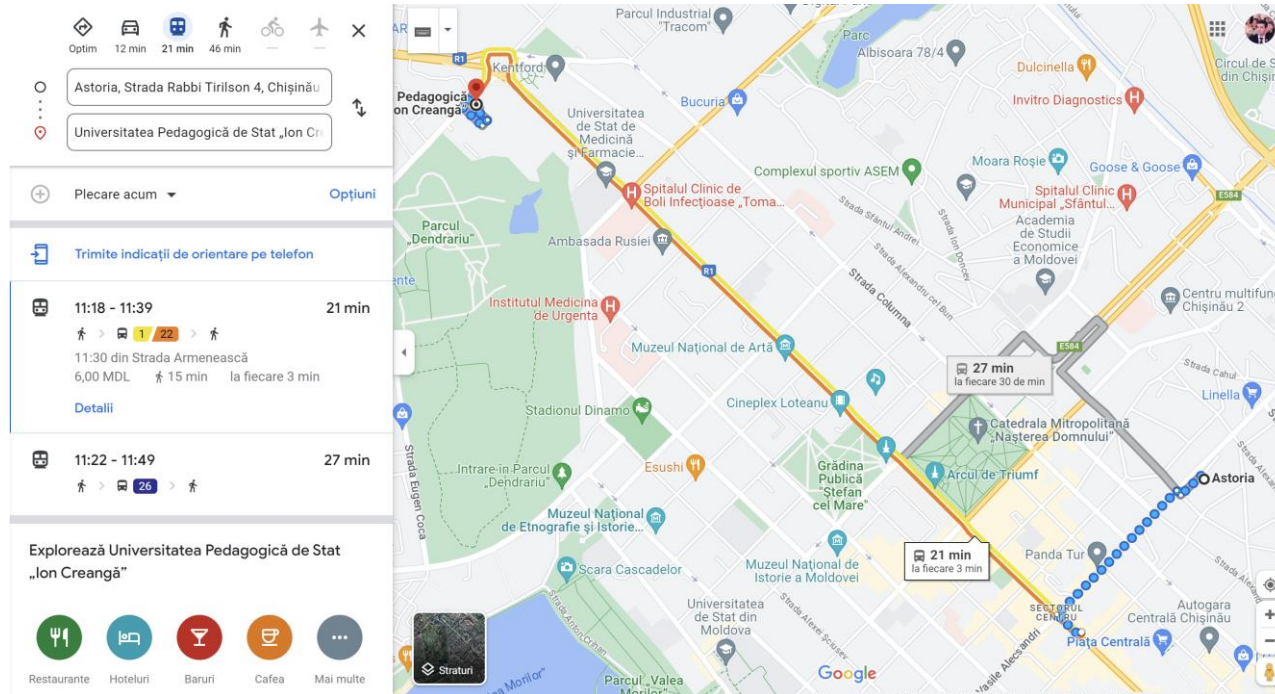
GENERAL INFORMATION
